



IN CASE OF INFECTION

No classroom lessons in case of sickness

Anyone who has a high temperature or is obviously ill, regardless of the cause, may neither attend school nor work there.

No classroom lessons

- for persons who have tested positive for SARS-CoV-2
- · for persons who are obliged to self-isolate/shield
- for persons who have reason to suspect they are infected with SARS-CoV

Test / access regulations

Proof of a negative test result, proof of vaccination or recovery from SARS-CoV-2.



REGULAR VENTILATION

- Rooms which are ventilated through the windows should be aired for approx. 5 minutes every 20 minutes.
- Rooms with air cleaning devices should also be ventilated every 20 minutes.



CONTACT DOCUMENTATION

- · Record the contact data of all visitors.
- Keep a seating chart and a record of the members (teachers and pupils) of each learning group.



SINGING AND MUSIC

Singing, choral speaking and playing wind instruments

- · Observe the ventilation regulations.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 1.5 metres if singing continues for more than 5 minutes.

DISTANCING



- The minimum distance need not always be observed during school activities.
- A distance of 1.5 metres to other persons should however be observed wherever possible.

HYGIENE



The general hygiene regulations (e.g. washing or sanitising hands regularly) continue to apply.

FACE MASKS




Observe the regulations for wearing face masks.

ACCESS RESTRICTIONS



Wherever possible, persons who are not taught at the school or who do not work there regularly should be granted access only after registration.

NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS



 Any positive rapid lateral flow test/self-test for SARS-CoV-2 must also be reported.
